
Brady Blog A Written Word from FBCG's Senior Pastor

Sermon Series (January-April)

sermon series entitled "Portraits of Jesus!". The purpose of this series is to look at portraits of the life of Jesus Christ each week from chapters 6-12 of John's Gospel as we approach Easter. One reason I believe our Lord laid this 14-week sermon series on my heart is so that our hearts will be prepared to fully Worship our Lord on the biggest holiday on the Christian Calendar, Easter.

Each week in this series we are looking at each verse that describes the life of our Lord while He was on the earth. The words that He spoke, the miracles that He performed and the things that He did. I don't know about you, but thus far the Lord has really used this series to show me personally that the Portraits of Jesus that we see in scripture, should be causing my life to become more of a reflection of Him daily. In essence, the way we live our lives should also be a portrait of Jesus.

On January 8th I preached the overview sermon of our series from John 20:30-31 which was entitled "The Purpose of the book of John!". Then, on January 15th I preached a message from John 6:1-15 entitled "Jesus the Provider!". On January 22nd we looked at John 6:16-21 with a sermon entitled "Jesus the God-man!". We wrapped up January with a sermon entitled "Jesus the Living Water!" from John 7:37-39. I encourage you to look at your copy of the 2023 preaching plan and find the other sermon titles and texts that we will be diving deeply into throughout February and March leading up to Easter Sunday.

Speaking of Easter Sunday, it is never to early to invite everyone you know to join us for Easter Worship! We will have our Sunrise service at 7 AM, breakfast following, and then Sunday School at 9:45 AM with Worship at 11 AM.
