'The Four-way Split!'

1st Corinthians 1:10-17

Rev. R. Brady Henderson

Sermon in a Sentence:

The family of God should be unified by and in the blood of Jesus Christ. In this text, the Corinthians Believers became divided, and Paul had to correct them, due to their forgetting who was on their team, fighting each other, forming cliques, and fleeing the foundations of their faith.

Question to Ask:

What leads a body of believers to split into divisions so quickly?

Truth #1: Forgetting Who is on our Team. (v. 10)

Truth #2: Fighting Each Other. (v. 11)

Truth #3: Forming Cliques. (vv. 12-13)

Truth #4: Fleeing the Foundations of our Faith. (vv. 14-17)
