Sermon #6 in Advance Sermon Series (1st Corinthians)

'Not By Human Might!'

1st Corinthians 2:1-5

Rev. R. Brady Henderson

Question to Ask:

What oratory tactics did Paul **avoid** and put into **action** when ministering to the Corinthians so that they would rest in the power of God and not by human might?

Truth #1: Avoiding Interesting Proclamation. (v. 1)

- Paul Avoided Greek Rhetoric.
- Paul Avoided 'Reinventing the Wheel'.

Truth #2: Acting on an Implemented Preaching Plan. (v. 2)

- The Purpose of Jesus Christ was the Preaching Plan Paul Implemented.

Truth #3: Avoiding Imperfect Predicaments. (v. 3)

- Paul didn't take advantage of their weakness.
- Paul didn't take advantage of their fears.

Truth #4: Avoiding Intellectual Persuasion. (vv. 4-5)

- If you can use Intellectual Persuasion to get someone to Christ, someone else can use it to get them out...
- Only by the Holy Spirit of God.
