Here are some recommendations from the American Library Association: Let children see the front of the book and some of the pages in the book so they can see the characters. Ask them to identify the characters, i.e., is it a bear? Let them tell you about the scenery. Read slowly and talk about what happens on each page. Let them tell you what they think will happen in the story.

Even the youngest children have tablets now but you can still talk to them about the games and characters they see. Children can learn to identify colors, shapes, numbers, letters and words on their tablets when you interact with them.
