“Mary’s Song: A Song of Reflection!”

Luke 1:46-56

Sermon in a Sentence:

Mary reacted to God’s plan for her by reflecting on what God had done for her, what God had for all people, and what God had done for Israel.

Question to Ask:

How does Mary react to the news that she will give birth to the Messiah and what does that show us about how we should react when God’s plan for us is revealed?

Point 1: She reflects on what God did for Her (V. 46-49)

- She Praised. (V. 46-47)
- She was Privileged to serve God. (V. 48)
- She had Proof of God’s Faithfulness. (V. 49)

Point 2: She reflects on what God has done for all people. (V. 50-53)

- Protection for those who fear Him. (V. 50-51)
- Peace for those who fear Him. (V. 52-53)

Point 3: She reflects on what God did for Israel. (V. 54-56) Providential Plan. (V. 54-55)
