'What to Pray When You Don't Know What to Say!'

Ezra 9:6-15

Rev. R. Brady Henderson

Sermon in a Sentence:

When we don't know what to say, but we know we need to pray, we can follow Ezra's solid example by confessing our shame and guilt, and then God could extend a clear sign of grace.

Question to Ask:

How does Ezra give us an example of how to pray when we are guilty of sin and don't know what to say?

Truth #1: A Confession of Shame. (vv. 6-9)

Truth #2: A Clear Sign of Grace. (vv. 10-15)
