A WRITTEN WORD FROM FBCG'S SENIOR PASTOR

Dear Church Family,

I am filled with overwhelming joy and gratitude as I write to you today. What God is doing in the life of our church is nothing short of miraculous—and I believe we are only beginning to see the fruit of our faith and obedience.

Many of you have asked about the new multi-purpose facility, and I'm thrilled to share more with you. We've begun calling it "The Field of Dreams," and what a fitting name it is! This new building will include a gymnasium, multiple classrooms, a kitchen, AV room, storage areas, and a welcoming central space for connection and fellowship. But more than the physical structure, it represents a God-given vision to reach our Gaston community with the love of Jesus through sports, education, discipleship, and worship.

As you know, our current sanctuary holds around 300 people. Lately, we've been averaging 287 each week—with 329 on campus this past Sunday alone! This is a good problem to have, but it is a problem we must address. Our plan is to hold simultaneous worship services in both the new gym and the sanctuary, making room for potentially 700–800 people each Sunday. This facility will also finally provide us with much-needed parking and expanded discipleship space for every generation.

We are truly stepping out on faith, believing that God is leading and providing every step of the way. I ask that you continue to pray with us—pray for wisdom, unity, and provision. Pray that God would place a hedge of protection over our church and guard us from any distraction or opposition the enemy may try to bring.

When I arrived in Gaston nearly five years ago, I never could have imagined all that God would do. But God—in His grace and goodness—has done far more than we could have asked or imagined. And I know He's not finished yet.

Let's keep moving forward together, with expectant hearts and unwavering faith. The best is yet to come!
