December 2024 A Written Word from FBCG's Senior Pastor Issue #46

It seems like yesterday I was writing the Brady Blog article for the January Newsletter. A lot has changed since January. We started this year with the word 'Committed,' and throughout the year, I've tried to remind you that our commitment to Christ, the Church, and one another matters. While I feel there's still room for improvement in the area of 'commitment,' I'm thankful for all that God has done this year. So far this year, we've seen 28 people join our Church, with 15 Baptisms and still more Baptisms to do before this year ends. It truly has been a great year, but I think we are still just scratching the surface of what God can and wants to continue to do in our midst. As we gear up for 2025, I want each of us to get ready. This is going to be a BIG upcoming year in the life of our Church. We are planning to add staff, move further along in our building process, and try new things! I'm coming up on year 5 of being your Senior Pastor and I couldn't be happier with where we are as a Church, but we must not get complacent! There's still much Gospel work to be done.

Our word of the year for 2025 is going to be selfless. The Lord has led me to this word from John 3:30. 'He must increase, but I must decrease'. The Lord has laid this word on my heart for our congregation to focus on this year. As your Pastor, I feel that we as a congregation can be tempted at times to think more *inwardly* than we do *outwardly*. Myself included, we worry about our own needs, our own personal programs, our own opinions, and our own preferences among other things. May we not forget that Matthew 28:16-20 is the mandate that Christ has given us as the Church to follow. 2025 will be a year of growth and changes for our Church. As we enter this year, we will be faced with challenges galore as we add additional staff and begin the process of building a multi-purpose facility. The Lord has reminded me that as a congregation for HIM to do all that He will do in 2025 at FBCG, you and I must remain *selfless* and not *selfish*.

The 2025 preaching plan will be available for you to pick up sometime this month. Not sure when yet, due to the time I am writing this edition of the 'Brady Blog' the preaching plan is not yet completed. I will be making Bible Reading plans available for you to pick -up in the welcome center as well. Please be patient with me this month as I try to get all this done, on top of all my regular duties as your Pastor.

December is going to be a big month here at the Church! We are going to start our 3-part Christmas Sermon Series entitled 'History of the Christmas Hymns!' on Wednesday, December 4th. On Wednesday, December 11th our Children will be presenting their Christmas musical. On Friday, December 13th Eternal Vision will be back with us to put on a Christmas concert. We will take up a love offering and the concert will start at 7 PM. On Sunday, December 15th we are going to be having our first (of hopefully many) SEND Sunday. We are going to celebrate the call of God on the Burtons to enter full-time Missionary service in Southeast Asia, as well as Emily Furtick who will be joining her fiance' in the ministry that he has been called to as a Youth Pastor. On December 15th we will hear their testimonies of what God has done, how we can pray for them, and what it means to live a SENT life from Matthew 28:16-20. On Wednesday, December 18th, Hannah and I will read the Christmas story to the children, and we will have our drop-in event immediately following.

There will be no worship services or on-campus activities on Wednesday, December 25th, and on Wednesday, January 1st.

I can't wait to see what God is going to do next.
