| 2025 | A Written Word from FBCG's Senior Pastor | #50 |

Greetings my beloved Church Family,

Long time, no see. By now, I know that most if not all of you are aware that during the month of March I took a 30-day sabbatical. The word 'Sabbatical' is generally defined as 'a paid leave of absence for the purpose of rest and renewal'. On Tuesday, February 25th I met with Mike Rollison, Allen Ott, and Duane Johnson for an emergency meeting. On the last Tuesday in February, I found myself 'burnt out'. I felt that I had hit a wall. For the last four years while serving First Baptist Church of Gaston in the role of Senior Pastor, I have neglected my family as well as my own personal relationship with God all under the 'banner' of 'the work of the ministry'. In reading and studying Exodus 18:13-27, the Lord revealed to me that this was not a sustainable approach to ministry nor was it Biblical. See, in Exodus 18:14, Jethro (Moses Father-in-law) asks Moses why he is doing EVERYTHING? Why is he trying to serve the people from sun up to sun down while neglecting his own family and relationship with the Lord. Church Family, as hard as it is for me to admit it, this is the trap that I had fallen into. I was tired, I was burnt out, and I got to a point where I just hit a wall that I couldn't break down. I do understand that the announcement of my sabbatical was abrupt and caught many of you 'off guard'. To tell you the truth, it caught me off guard. But, the Lord made it plain and clear to me that I needed to ask the Church leadership for time off in order to save my ministry, marriage, and be restored in my personal relationship with God.

What happened to me, can happen to any of us no matter what our vocation is. It's important that we truly rest when the Lord leads us to, something I had not been doing in the last four years. Statistics tell us that the Pastorate in the United States is the 2nd most stressful job that a person can have. Statistics also tell us that more Pastors commit suicide every year than any other vocation. I also know that only 10% of those who start in the ministry, will actually retire in the ministry. Church family, the Lord directed me to take a 30-day sabbatical during this season so that I don't become one of those statistics. Trust me, I love being your Pastor, and I love getting to do what I know God has called me to do by serving as your Pastor, but I also know that when God speaks, I must listen. I became depressed, exhausted, and to be completely honest, I lost who I was as a person by exerting too much energy in my work. And here's the thing, it wasn't your fault as a congregation. I don't want you to feel like you were too demanding or 'needy'. Because in all reality, I needed to learn how to say 'no', and I believe that's something I've learned in the last 30-days in my personal relationship with the Lord. It was my own personal fault as a Pastor and as the man of my household that I did not prioritize correctly and I did not set proper boundaries so that I could avoid burnout, despite the advice that many of you have given me over the last four years. In the future, I ask that you be understanding and offer Grace when I have to say 'no', or when I choose to delegate a specific task or home/hospital visit to a staff member or Deacon. While I won't apologize for taking a needed sabbatical, I will say that this could have been avoided had I listened to Jethro's warning to Moses in Exodus 18:13-27 One thing I want you to remember, is that I am just a human being. Just like you. I have fault and failures DAILY, just like you do. I appreciate and covet your prayers always.

I will be returning to the pulpit on Sunday, March 30th, as I deliver a 'special' sermon on what God has done in my life and taught me in the last 30 days. My first official day back in the office/study of FBCG will be on Monday, March 31st. Moving forward, you will see and find our Deacons even more involved in visitation and other duties (as assigned) as well as Pastor Steve.

While I will still spend time on Pastoral Care, it won't be the focus of my ministry moving forward. In other words, 'people pleasing' will not be my number one priority. Instead, I am going to focus on God pleasing. The Deacons and Pastor Steve, according to Scripture (Acts 6) are to fulfill the role of caring for the congregation while I devote the majority of my time to my personal walk with God, my family, study, and oversight/ administration of the Church. In addition to this change moving forward, if you wish to make a personal appointment with me (counseling or something else), you will need to call Mrs. Velvet at the Church office phone number (803)-794-0377 to find out my availability and to schedule an appointment. This will help me to better prioritize my study time. I'm still going to meet and counsel with you based on the personal needs you have, but I just ask that you go through Velvet instead of me directly, as she knows my daily schedule and whereabouts.

Lastly, Holy Week is upon us! On Sunday, April 20th we will celebrate Easter Sunday. Join us at 7 AM for Sonrise Service inside the sanctuary, breakfast to follow in the fellowship hall, 9:45 AM Sunday School/Small Groups, and Worship at 11 AM. I have created a Holy Week devotional that you can access online or pick up a copy in the welcome center. I love you all and I'm happy to be back.
